



May - 2024 Directors Report

Precinct official training is completed in May with only 3 to train on the day of election supply pickup. All is prepared for the election day the equipment is ready and election early walk in voting preparation is all done. The absentees in the nail will be processed on Thursday before the election date and scanned on election day. With so few it will not take much time to process them on Saturday.

Redistricting is being looked at and precincts and polling places are being considered once we have everything in place number-wise.

We are ready for the election process.

§22. Registration Process.

B. <u>Cards</u>. The Election Commission Office shall issue <u>V</u>voter <u>I</u>identification <u>C</u>eards to <u>R</u>registered <u>V</u>voters. Whenever possible, the eard should be in a picture ID format. The eard maybe used as a convenient means of identification of person whose names appear on the <u>V</u>voters <u>L</u>list.

Currently:

- The Election Commission mails an acknowledgement card to each voter, in district or At Large, once they have registered or updated their information in our system.
- Voter ID cards are mailed out to in district voters within the reservation after our voter registration deadline closes.
- We know by word of mouth that many times these Voter ID cards serve as a reminder to voters that an election is coming up.

Issues:

- The acknowledgement card typically causes confusion with At Large voters making them think they need to call and request an absentee ballot.
- The timeline we mail our Voter ID cards leaves no room to correct any errors on the card.
- We currently do not have the capability to print an updated card even if we correct an error.

Proposed:

- Cease mailing acknowledgement cards. They are not called for in the Election Law.
- Since we know the mailing of these cards serves as a reminder of an upcoming election
 and we know the Commission wants to continue to mail cards every Election Cycle, we
 propose to mail Voter ID cards to all Registered Voters including At Large voters. These
 cards would still be printed by Mid-West, with postage and mailing still being done in
 house.
- The mailing of these cards would be at the beginning of the Election Cycle and would not only allow for all citizens (not just in district voters) to be reminded of an upcoming election, but would allow the staff to make necessary updates to a voter's registration prior to the March deadline when no changes could take place.
- We would also have the software updates in place to be able to print a Voter ID card in house serving a twofold purpose. First, if the initial voter card mailed out at the beginning of the cycle had an error, we could fix, reprint and send a new one and secondly, anytime a voter submitted a voter registration we could mail them a Voter ID card with their updated information rather than an Acknowledgement Card.

In conclusion, this fulfills the requirements of the Election Law, allows us to eliminate a post card that had caused a great deal of confusion and gives us the ability to print and send our own Voter ID cards when an update is made. Further, we feel this new standard in mailing Voter ID cards to all Registered Voters will better serve all voters.
