
I. OFFICE:

The election went well only 1 machine had a error with a scanner the equipment was changed out and it was sone before the first voter.

Other issues will be handled with additional direction of duties on election night returns. With an evaluation of precinct officials some of these issues will be taken care of. We will be training longer and harder to achieve a better election process.

Now we are in redistricting now and CSA has reported that it is moving right along and will soon be receiving updated street segments by county. Once all have been checked for exceptions, they will remain in a status of unapproved till all segments have been received and reviewed. Then will review and approve all the segments to move forward. Then the reports can be printed with information with numbers of the registered voters.

July work is addressing unassigned voters and voters tagged with bad addresses.
