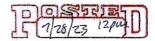

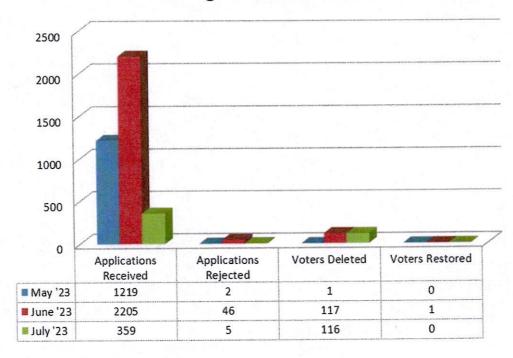
### I. OFFICE:
