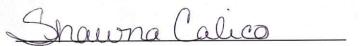

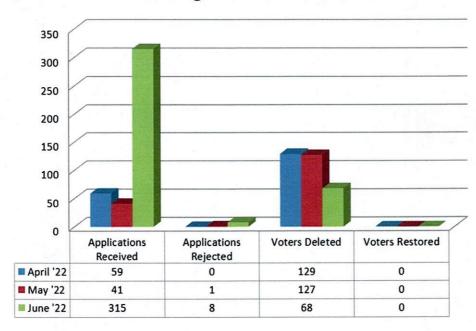
I. OFFICE:
