





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
**I. OFFICE:**

Precinct official training is complete. It went well this time, it just seemed that we had a lot of replacements at the precincts. Luckily, they all happened before they were trained so far.

Finished 35 machines on May 22 these are the machines that we will be using for the 6-7-25 election. The work on the equipment included the PM's on the equipment. I will finish the PM's on the rest of the equipment after this election cycle. I did discover errors in 4 scanners that will have to go in for repairs. They have been reported to Hart and the return is in the works now.

In the next week the completion of the supplies will be assembled and prepared for the Inspector to pick up on late Thursday (June 5) and all-day Friday June 6.

We have Absentee ballots returned undeliverable (38 total so far) no response from 26 of the voters, 17 were re-sent after correcting the address entered wrong.
